Mid-range hotel in Cottbus

Schedule

Day 1 Friday

Group travel to Cottbus – hotel check-in in Cottbus

Branitz Castle and Park visit plus tour – seeking the traces of Prince Pueckler, the ingenious creator of gardening art and parks. Dinner at hotel
Overnight stay in Cottbus

Day 2 - Saturday

After breakfast, trip to Raddusch located in the Spreewald region.

Visit the recently opened "Slavic fortress Raddusch" – an unusual walk through Brandenburg's prehistoric and early history period.

After that you will go to Burg, Spreewald and undertake a boat tour through the Spreewald forests and acquire a "Spreewald diploma", an unforgettable experience. Take part later in the barn festival in a rustic atmosphere inside the "Kolonieschaenke" in Burg.

After that, you will return to your hotel in Cottbus and spend the night there.

Day 3 - Sunday

After the breakfast, you will be going to Jaenschwalde, the location of one of Europe's most modern coal-fired power stations (lignite).

Take on a tour outside and inside the power station and go up to the viewing platform at a height of 60 metres and enjoy the wonderful roundview of Lusatia. Continue your trip by going to the F 60 mine that is open to visitors in Lichterfeld and pick up a little snack from the conveyor band"
