Schedule:

Day 1 - Arrival

Arrival at the hotel in Potsdam – a royal and garrison town.

After your check-in you can opt for a walk along Potsdam's Old Market Square (Alter Markt) and the Dutch Quarter. (optional)

Day 2 – Highlights of Potsdam

After breakfast a sightseeing tour awaits you. You will get to see Schinkel's Church of St. Nikolai, the Fortuna Gate of the Potsdam castle, the Marstall – formerly the royal stables and now Potsdam's Filmmuseum, the House of Brandenburg-Prussian History, the Russian Colony Alexandrowka, the Dutch Quarter, Glienicke bridge and the "forbidden city".

After that, you get to walk through the park that leads you to Sanssouci Castle, which you will be visiting inside, of course. Subsequent to the Sanssouci tour, you are taken to the Bornstedt Crown Estate, the agricultural estate model of the Crown Prince of the Hohenzollern dynasty.

Only 500 metres separate the Crown Estate from Sanssouci castle. A tour guide will introduce you to the Crown Estate to enable you to explore the site on your own. Not only local culinary specialties are served in the restaurant, but also, you will get to see you also get to see activities of traditional craftsmen from Potsdam and the federal state: There is a glass blowing workshop and you will find many little art and craft shops here as well. Now it is time to have lunch or sit down for a coffee or tea.

In the late afternoon you can enjoy the baroque city centre or alternatively, you can take a walk through the villa colony of Neubabelsberg where movie stars from the 20's used to live and where Truman, Churchill and Stalin resided during the Potsdam Conference in 1945.

Day 3 – Marvellous views

After breakfast, you are taken the Belvedere on Pfingstberg hill, the highest situated castle of the Prussian Kings. Its renovation is owed to private initiatives, otherwise this jewel, built in the 19th century, would have deteriorated. Now, the Belvedere is open to visitors and from one of the towers you have a breathtaking round view of Potsdam's cultural landscape, part of the UNESCO's world heritage. (a castle visit is charged extra) Later on, you can stroll through the Neuer Garten, which is located on the bottom of Pfingstberg hill. Inside the park you will see Cecilienhof Castle, which is our next highlight. A tour guide takes you inside Cecilienhof, a castle of the Hohenzollern dynasty, built at a later time, in which you will be shown the private rooms of Crown Princess Cecile. The second part of the tour is dedicated to the castle section in which the Potsdam Conference was held from July to August of 1945. (optional) Last but not least, a boat tour along the many beautiful castles finishes off this spectacular day in Potsdam.
